## TENURE-TRACK APPOINTMENTS

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The Faculty of Law at the University of Victoria is widely acknowledged as one of Canada's finest law schools. We especially invite applications from those with interests in Administrative Law, Corporate-Commercial Law (including Contracts), Criminal Law, Evidence and Property. At least one of the two appointments is expected to be made in these subject areas.

The successful applicants will have an LL.B. or J.D. and an LL.M., PhD. or other relevant graduate degree, and demonstrated excellence or a potential for excellence in teaching and research. A strong commitment to teach in the First Year Program and to Graduate supervision is essential.

The Faculty expects to make appointments that will enrich our innovative teaching and research program and continue our commitment to a collegial, diverse and involved community.

Applications, consisting of a cover letter that specifies areas of teaching and research interests, a *curriculum vitae*, copies of LL.B (or J.D) and graduate transcripts, the names of (and contact information for) three academic references, copies of two sample publications or other samples of academic writing, and sample teaching syllabi (if available), should be received by **December 15, 2011**.
